Lab 3

In this lab, you are to copy your submission for lab1 and lab2 to `lab1.html` and `lab2.html` respectively first.

1. Create a homepage for your CSCI101 labs as `index.html`. You should include a link to `lab1.html` and `lab2.html` as well as `lab3.html` with appropriate text description. This will serve as your index.
2. Create `lab3.html`. In `lab3.html`, I want you to insert your favourite English poem. Use appropriate HTML to cite your reference and provide a hyperlink to your source.
3. Lookup `style` attribute. Use it to make your poem in `lab3.html` centre-aligned. You will need to use `"text-align:center"`. This is tapping into the realm of CSS, what we call **inline css**: https://www.w3schools.com/css/css_howto.asp.
