You must make sufficient effort to ensure the submitted webpage is properly formatted. Failure to comply will result in a ZERO grade. Your submission must be a zip file with the following file structure:

Lab 4

In this lab, you are to correct an HTML webpage submitted by a student named Ug Citej. Download this zip file: https://jetic.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/02/04-2024-1002-204_Lab4.zip, extract all files, and start working on it.

1. Use an HTML validator to find out what's wrong with `index.html`, and fix these issues. You can choose any HTML validator online.
2. You'll notice that `index.html` is linking `style.css` wrong. Fix that.
3. Inside `style.css`, do the following:
 1. Centre the `<h2>` with the `text-align` property.
 2. Give the `<h2>` a `background-color`.
 3. Change the font-family for the headings (`<h1>` and `<h2>`) to one of the other generic font families.
 4. Space lines (everywhere in the `<body>`) more by setting the `line-height` to something between 1.2 (which seems to be close to the default) and 2.0: whatever looks nice to you.
 5. Provide a border of some kind to the `<main>` element.

Grading criteria

- Grading will be performed based on 1 factor:
 1. Proper HTML/CSS formatting as per requirements above.
