## Lab 5

In this lab, you are to reformat your previous lab submissions using the provided CSS file from Assignment 2.

1. Use `<link>` to reference the provided `style.css` from Assignment 2 in all of your HTML files.
2. Reformat all your HTML files to use the style template. You should not use inline CSS for this, modify your HTML files to comply with `style.css`. Make sure every HTML file look similar in style.
  1. The title should be adequately styled, just like the template in Assignment 2.
  2. There cannot be overflow of content.
  3. If you have images, change their dimensions to fit the `<div>` box. There cannot be overflow.
3. Inside `style.css`, do the following:
  1. Lookup <https://developer.mozilla.org/en-US/docs/Web/CSS/list-style>
  2. Create some CSS styling options for lists that you used, use `circle` points.
  3. Just like above, there cannot be overflow of text.
